### Main duties

- To teach Islamic Studies to children aged 11 to 15 years old.
- To plan lessons and assess learning to ensure that the quality of teaching and learning is consistently good or better.
- Manage children's learning and behaviour following the school's policy and procedures.
- Work with parents as active partners, and provide parents with verbal and written reports of their children's achievement and progress.
- To teach children to learn about Islam and provide them with enthusiasm and inspiration to be a practising Muslim.
- To help children with the development of positive behaviour and attitude by being a good role model and a source of support. Also to allow children to learn from their mistakes with care and kindness.
- Participate in regular in-service training and work as a part of a team.

### Qualifications

- GCSE or A Level [or equivalent] in Islamic Studies is essential, a degree in the subject is desirable. However, alternative qualifications may also be considered.
- Completed formal studies in Islamic Studies (desirable).
- Good further/higher education, preferably in the UK.

- Good knowledge of teaching Islamic Studies.
- Knowledge and understanding of how children learn, and how to support children's learning.
