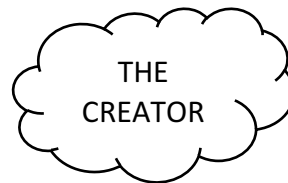
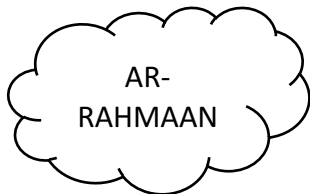
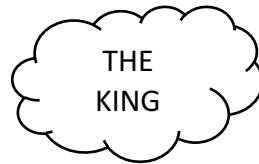


Home Learning Week 1: Revision
