

# Izhaar

Today, we're going to learn the tajweed rule called Izhaar.

## What is Izhaar?

Izhaar is when there is a نْ (noon Saakin) or ً (tanween) and the letters خ، غ، ح، ع، ه، ء come after it, you must read the noon saakin and tanween clearly.
