

Home Learning Week 14:


L.O: Today we are going to learn about why people go to Hajj and the main lessons we can learn.

As you know, Hajj is the 5th pillar of Islam. It is a visit to the Ka'bah which is the house of Allah in Makkah. It is also a once in a lifetime opportunity for Muslims around the world (who can afford and are physically fit) to make this journey as it allows them to re-connect with Islam and Allah and be forgiven of their sins and bad deeds.

One of the most important lessons from Hajj is that we are all equal. This is learnt as muslims of all backgrounds perform Hajj together and are all dressed the same (in a very simple form of dress/Ihram). This shows that everyone has the same status in Islam and the house of Allah, we are all His servants.

Another lesson we can take from Hajj is that it reminds us of the importance of life and death as we are reminded of our goal in this life. We are here to please and worship Allah. We learn that we belong to Allah and we return to Him so we must do as He commands because if we do, we will be successful in this life and enjoy life in Jannah.
