As we know, Tawheed is the most important belief in Islam because it means that everyone on this earth and everything around us, has been created by Allah and only Allah. This is because He is the most powerful - He has no partners, children or parents. This is mentioned in the shahadah when we declare that 'there is no God but Allah, and Muhammad (s.a.w) is Allah's messenger'. Saying and believing this in our hearts is a very important duty for ALL muslims.

Now that you have read this, answer the following questions in your books:

- 2. Can you give any examples of when muslims tend to say or recite the shahadah?

Tayammum can be used when the water available is insufficient for Wudu. An example of this can be when we are travelling and only carrying a small amount of water with us.

We can use Tayammum when water is not available to us.

It can be used when using water for Wudu could be harmful. E.g When we are sick or have a particular illness.

Tayammum can be used when we feel lazy or too cold to use water for Wudu.




